PROFESSION OF FAITH

We worship one God in trinity and the Trinity in unity, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the divine being. For the Father is one person, the Son is another, and the Spirit is still another. But the deity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one, equal in glory, coeternal in majesty. The Father is God; the Son is God; the Holy Spirit is God: And yet there are not three gods, but one God. For this is the true faith that we believe and confess: that our Lord Jesus Christ, God's Son, is both God and man. Although He is God and man, He is not divided, but is one Christ. He is united because God has taken humanity into Himself; He does not transform deity into humanity. He is completely one in the unity of his person, without confusing His natures. He suffered death for our salvation, and rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead. - Taken from The Athanasian Creed
